

# Prayer Watchtower

## Saturday 6th February 2016



**16** people representing 6 congregations from across the borough of Southwark gathered to pray at William Booth College tower. 14 people prayed at the top of the tower and two stayed at the bottom in the prayer room.

We focussed on the **seven spheres of influence** – Family; arts/entertainment/media/ religion/ tech/ innovation/science; business; education; government.

Before we ascended one person shared a dream he had experienced of gathering intercessors from across denominations to pray in Burgess Park which catapulted into praying in governmental buildings.

### Here's some of our prayers...



Saw the tower as a lighthouse reaching into the shadows across North, South, East and West.

There was one overwhelming message that came from the morning – those up the tower and those on the ground:

We were reminded of the church in Sardis – The Lord always has a remnant. Wake-up what is about to die and see it revived again.

There is a trumpet call sounding. God is saying things NOW – Awaken. Intercession is taking a hold, people are burdened to

pray. Let's be re-ignited in unified prayer.

There were **tears** - like those of Jesus weeping over Jerusalem – tears over the rebellion and stubbornness of the church.

**You have authority** – the church has authority we need to work it and be good stewards of it. We have the keys in our pockets we need to take them out and use them. Declare God's word over the land. Prayer does wonders. Don't despise the day of small beginnings.

Whilst looking at the London Eye and the Shard one person had the sense that God is blinding the enemy's eye so he can't see what God is doing.
